

### Hearts for Hearing Adult Clinic Audiology Fourth-Year Externship Overview

Hearts for Hearing (HFH) is a 501c3 non-profit audiology and auditory-verbal therapy (AVT) clinic for children and adults with hearing and vestibular issues. By offering a comprehensive array of services and treatment options, children and adults with hearing loss have the opportunity to listen for a lifetime.

#### **GOALS:**

The purpose of the externship program is to provide extensive experience to doctoral students in the field of clinical audiology, with a particular emphasis on adult diagnostic evaluations, hearing aids and tinnitus/sound sensitivity management. Opportunities to train with audiologists specializing in vestibular audiology, pediatric care, cochlear implants, and/or audiology research can be incorporated if desired. At the completion of the program, the individual should be comfortable performing all aspects of audiometric diagnostic testing and providing most audiological treatment options with complete independence. The student will also be able to exhibit confidence in the student's professionalism and leadership and teamwork skills.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Clinical responsibilities can include and are not limited to:

- Comprehensive otoscopic examinations
- Acoustic immittance testing
- Comprehensive audiometric diagnostic testing
- Otoacoustic emission testing and interpretation
- Vestibular diagnostic testing (including electrophysiological testing) and interpretation
- Tinnitus and other sound sensitivity diagnostic testing and treatment/counseling
- Hearing aid and/or bone conduction hearing aid selection
- Hearing technology fittings and verification using real ear measurements
- Lyric candidacy and fittings

Professional responsibilities can include and are not limited to:

- Motivational interviewing
- Patient and family-centered care
- Interdisciplinary collaboration with other medical professionals
- Community outreach events
- Exposure to business operations

If desired, the extern can learn basics of vestibular testing and treatment, cochlear implant technology (candidacy evaluation, programming, and verification), FM systems (evaluation, fitting, and verification), electrophysiological testing, and research. Supervision will be provided by a team of experienced audiologists who hold their Certificates of Clinical Competency in Audiology.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

Interested individuals should be highly motivated, self-directed, and possess a strong interest in working with adults with hearing loss and/or vestibular issues. Exceptional academic, communication, interpersonal skills are needed.

#### If selected as an intern at Hearts for Hearing the following must be provided prior to first day of clinic:

- 1. Documentation of personal or university-provided malpractice coverage
- 2. Documentation of CPR certification
- 3. Documentation of recent (within the past year) TB test results
